


Private Coverage Options

- ► Employer-sponsored plan
- ► Exchange coverage
- ► Individual plan
- ► COBRA or Continuation of Coverage
- ► Short-term coverage
- Medigap (or Supplemental)




Types of Insurance Coverage

- ► Health Maintenance Organization (HMO)
- Exclusive Provider Organization (EPO)
- Point of Service Plan (POS)
- Preferred Provider Organization (PPO)
- ► High Deductible Plan (with or without HSA)



Public Health Insurance Options

- Medicare
 - ► Traditional Fee-For-Service
 - ► Medicare Advantage
- Medicaid
- ► VA
- ► CHIP
- ► High Risk Pools

Medicare Open Enrollment ends December 7, 2021 - Things to Consider


- What are your out-of-pocket expenses
 - ► How much are you personally responsible for?
 - ▶ What is the deductible?
 - ► How much is the coinsurance?
 - ▶ Is there an out-of-pocket maximum?
 - ► Can you purchase a supplementary plan? How much does it cost?



Additional Issues to Consider

- Provider Network
 - What types of insurance do your doctors accept?
- Are your current medications covered if you switch plans?
 - ▶ Does your plan have a formulary or require step-therapy?

- Do you need additional benefits, such as dental, vision or transportation?
 - What if those benefits go away in subsequent years?
- What is the cost of changing plans later?

Ongoing Advocacy for The Jack Reynolds Memorial Medigap Expansion Act (H.R. 1676)



- ► This bill was introduced by U.S. Reps. Cynthia Axne (D-IA-03) and Herrera Beutler (R-WA-03).
 - ► Jack was one of Rep. Axne's constituents.
- ▶ It would require Medigap plans to offer coverage to all ESRD Medicare beneficiaries regardless of age.


Why do ESRD Patients Need Medigap?

- ► Financial Security to cover the 20% coinsurance costs that Medicare does not cover
- Increase dialysis patient access to transplant





Interactive DPC Medigap Report Card for Individuals with ESRD under 65 years old



Medigap Report Card Key

- State requires **all/most plans** to be **offered and affordable** to ESRD patients under 65.
- B State requires **some plans** to be **offered and affordable** to ESRD patients under 65.
- State requires **some plans** to be **offered**, but they are **not affordable** to most ESRD patients under 65.
- State does not require coverage. Some plans are offered, but they are not affordable to most ESRD patients under 65.
- State **excludes** coverage. **Some plans** may be **offered**, but they are **not affordable** to most ESRD patients under 65.

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Medigap Access is Vital for Dialysis Patients Under Age 65

Alabama Medigap Grade: D

Alabama does not require coverage for ESRD patients under age 65

- Some insurers offer plans 1
- · Most plans are not affordable 1

Alabama Dialysis Patient Facts

- 13,599 residents with kidney failure, also known as End Stage Renal Disease (ESRD)²
- 8,781 residents are on the kidney transplant wait-list ³
- Approximately 5,000 dialysis patients nationally die each year while waiting for a transplant ⁴


To Achieve an "A" Grade, Alabama Should:

- Accessibility: Require all Medigap plans be offered to ESRD patients under age 65
- Affordability: Require plan premiums be community-rated, i.e., same rate without regard to age, health status or other factors

Providing Greater Financial Security:


· Medicare Part B has no limit on the annual 20% out-of-pocket co-insurance and co-pays. Medigap provides






Medigap Options for Individuals under 65

Medigap Level	Medigap for individuals with ESRD under age 65	States	# of non-dual Medicare enrollees with ESRD under age 65 (2019)
Α	State requires all or most Medigap plans and limits premiums	CT, HI, KS, ME, MN, NY, OR, PA	13,100
В	State requires some plans and limits premiums	ID, MD, MO, NJ, OK, SD	11,100
С	State requires some plans, but does not limit premiums	AR, CO, DE, FL, GA, IL, IN, LA, MI, MS, MT, NH, TN, TX, WI	46,600
D	State does not require any plans, some plans are available but are generally unaffordable	AL, AK, AZ, DC, IA, KY, NC, ND, NE, NM, NV, OH, RI, SC, UT, WA, WV, WY	22,500
F	State excludes coverage, some plans are available but are generally unaffordable	CA, MA, VA, VT	11,400



Estimated Medigap Premium Impact




Allowing individuals with ESRD to enroll in any Medigap plan would raise overall premiums by approximately 0.7%

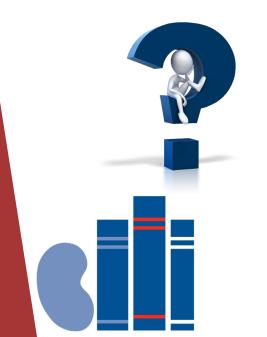
